

JOHN ADAMS FUND

The John Adams Fund was established in 2012 by members of the Billygoats Society in recognition of John Adams' fifty years of service to the Society and Fitzwilliam College rowing.

The Awards

The income of the John Adams Fund shall be used to provide prizes and bursaries as proposed by Officers of the Billygoats Society (President, Secretary and Treasurer) and approved by the Tutorial Committee.

One or more **John Adams Prizes** may be awarded annually to student members of the College who have done most to promote the wellbeing and success of the Boat Club.

John Adams Bursaries may be awarded to student members of the college who have incurred expenses in connection with rowing either for the Boat Club or for University crews.

Value

The value of a John Adams Prize shall be £100.

The value of a John Adams Bursary shall not exceed the amount of the expenses incurred.

The total value of John Adams Prizes and Bursaries in any year shall not exceed the income of the fund in that year, and any surplus shall be re-invested.
